### MINUTES

- 1. Overview of golf course and food & beverage operations:

### • <u>Monthly Client Report – KemperSports</u>

- 2. <u>July Financials</u> July 2014 net operating income was a loss of \$21,366 this was a loss \$6,857 greater than budget for July. Total rounds of golf were under budget by 39%, which was the main reason for this excessive shortfall in financial outcome.
- <u>August Financials</u> August 2014 net operating income was a loss of \$11,857 this was \$9,250 less than the loss budgeted for the month. Total rounds of golf exceeded budget by 8%, however, payroll was under budget 25% and other operating cost were under budget 22%. A large factor contributing to an increase in rounds of golf was a slash in rates to become more competitive.
- 4. <u>Food and Beverage</u> The Nest will continue to cater tournaments and special events. Sandwiches, hot dogs, soft drinks and beer will continue to be sold at the club house sandwiches have been successful and sell out. We have a new cook (Shawn) and that has help in prep for food at the club house as well as keeping the F&B within budget. We recently hosted a 70 player event with lunch and a steak dinner after golf and it was very successful.
- 5. <u>Grounds & Landscaping</u> Mike, who is manager of grounds keeping has been out with a very serious illness for several months he has recently returned. We are all happy he is doing well and have missed his expertise. The course will get more attention. Also, Scott will check with locals to find a mover with long arms for mowing the dead reeds around the ponds.
- 6. <u>*Capital Items*</u> The committee agreed the top priority is to purchase or lease a much needed mover. Steve Argo will review used equipment for a better price on this acquisition.

The meeting was adjourned 5:50 PM. The next meeting is scheduled for November 4, 2014.
