Fruit Tree Workshop Class January 10

(Woodland, CA) – Calling all fruit tree and garden enthusiasts! The Hanna and Herbert Bauer Memorial Community garden in Woodland will host a fruit tree workshop on Saturday, January 10, 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This outdoor class is free and open to all; no experience with fruit trees necessary.

This class, taught by a Yolo County master gardener who specializes in fruit trees, will help participants select bare root fruit trees for their home orchard. Participants will also learn how to properly train and trim fruit trees during the winter dormant season to enhance growth and production in spring. The class will take place in the garden orchard on the west side of the Bauer building at 137 N. Cottonwood Avenue in Woodland, and will include demonstration of various training and trimming techniques.

Yolo County's Hanna and Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden education program is committed to offering residents opportunities to learn how gardening can help with living healthier and more active lives.
