Yolo County and City of West Sacramento Host Job Fair

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County One-Stop Career Center, in partnership with the City of West Sacramento, is hosting a job fair for those interested in employment in manufacturing and skilled trades. The job fair will be held on Thursday, March 6, 2008, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Galleria at the West Sacramento City Hall, located at 1110 West Capitol Avenue in West Sacramento.

Representatives from approximately 30 Sacramento area employers, apprenticeship programs and One-Stop partners will be on hand to meet with job seekers. Information will be available on positions in the fields of welding and fabrication, electrical, construction, electronics assembly, production, and engineering. Job seekers are asked to bring their resume.

“Job fairs like this are an avenue for Yolo County residents to access multiple employment possibilities in one location,” said Pam Miller, Yolo County Department of Employment and Social Services Director. “It is exciting to be able to bring numerous employers and job seekers together in one event, and it enables us to follow our vision of developing and strengthening the workforce in partnership with the community.”
