SUBJECT: Environmental analysis for the proposed El Macero Villas project

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Applicant: Don Fouts Fouts Construction Davis, CA File Number: ZF2014-0036

**Description of Project:** The application is a request for approval of a General Plan Amendment GPA, rezoning, lot line adjustment, and Tentative Parcel Map for the El Macero Villas project, a 16 unit residential condominium development on the western portion of the El Macero Golf Course. The site is located near the western intersection of Mace Boulevard and San Marino Drive in an unincorporated area of Davis. The project will create for-sale residential condominiums, consisting of three two-story buildings. Access will be via two ungated entrances on Mace Boulevard. The project will connect to City of Davis water and sewer facilities. The approximately 2.4-acre area planned for the project has been used as the golf course corporation and storage yard. A portion of an adjacent pond on the golf course will be utilized for the project.

**Environmental Determination:** An Initial Study was prepared to examine potential areas of impact resulting from the project. The Initial Study found that the proposed project, with mitigation, would not have a significant effect on the environment. As a result, a Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared.
