My Grandmother, The Great Migration and African-American Spirituals

(Woodland, CA) – In honor of Black History Month, Lellingby Boyce will perform “My Grandmother, The Great Migration and African-American Spirituals” on Sunday, February 15, 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the Blanchard Room of the Mary L. Stephens Davis Branch Library, located at 315 E. 14th Street in Davis.

“My Grandmother, The Great Migration and African-American Spirituals” is the story of Boyce’s grandmother and the historical Great Migration that altered her grandmother's life. The Great Migration was the movement of six million African-Americans out of the rural Southern United States to the urban Northeast, Midwest and West.

Boyce’s earlier public performances feature African-American spirituals and storytelling. Since then, she has presented recitals of songs and operatic arias and lively audience-participation programs of Broadway's gems. “My Grandmother, The Great Migration and African-American Spirituals” is a richly tapestried program of history and personal memories, accompanied by a musical score of sing-alongs.
