- creates a dynamic county-wide, long-term, future-oriented process of evaluation, assessment, decision/policy-making and implementation

Develops multi-year policy plans that links the present environment with a desired vision of the future, indicating where resources are to be concentrated

#### **Current Organizational Priorities**

- Facilities and space planning (Capital Improvement Plan)
- Implementation of InforSystem and Talent Development program
- Countywide implementation of Yolo Performance and related dashboards
- Law & Justice case management system development and implementation
- Outreach/education on county programs and services

#### Goal: Thriving Residents



#### Meaning

(Expanded definition of the Strategic Plan Goal)

Social, economic and physical environments are created and supported which promote good health and protect vulnerable populations so that community members and future generations have the opportunity to learn and grow to their full potential.

#### **Key Concepts** (Actionable items reflected in the meaning)

Promote healthy communities:
Create and improve physical and social environments and expand community resources that enable residents to make healthy lifestyle choices, decrease their risk of chronic disease and develop to their maximum potential

Protect and support vulnerable populations: Protect and support those at risk for physical, emotional or economic harm (including the poor, mentally ill, elderly, homeless, physically disabled, families with children and children at risk for abuse, delinquency or already under jurisdiction of the Court)

**Protect consumers**: Consumers are protected from fraud, public health threats, safety hazards, substandard housing and blighted conditions.

Achieve and maintain selfsufficiency: Provide services (including safety net) and opportunities that support wellness and the economic and food security of residents so they can contribute to the stability of themselves, their families, the community and future generations

#### Implement Community Health Improvement Plan

(Focus Areas: mental health, healthy aging and chronic disease prevention)

#### **Possible Measures of Success**

- Heart disease; CalFresh participation; food deserts
- Access to preventative oral health measures
- Injuries to older adults due to falls; commits to skilled nursing
- Suicide rate; substance abuse

#### Develop and implement strategies to reduce homelessness \*

- Permanently housed and related retention rates
- Receiving income and benefits
- Emergency care and psychiatric hospitalization
- Arrests/tickets and days in jail
- Chronically/long-term homeless

#### Expand best practices in programs benefitting children \*

- Number/time in foster care and probation/justice system; in-county placements
- Recidivism rate
- Childhood trauma; child support
- Preschool enrollment; 3rd grade literacy levels

#### Goal: Safe Communities

Ensure safe communities: Hold offenders accountable, restore victims and enforce code requirements to protect residents and visitors from unfair practices and unsafe conditions

#### **Possible Measures of Success**

- Coordinated community services mapping


#### Goal: Flourishing Agriculture
