“Día de los Niños / Día de los Libros brings families together and emphasizes the importance of literacy for every child, inclusive of linguistic and cultural background,” said Yolo County Librarian Patty Wong. “The Yolo County Library is committed to providing families with literacy resources and literacy-based programming in several languages.”

Día de los Niños / Día de los Libros is a nationwide celebration of children, families and reading held annually on or around April 30. Children’s author and bilingual advocate Pat Mora founded the event in 1996 and the Yolo County Library has been celebrating the event since 2012. The slogan for Día de los Niños / Día de los Libros is “Many children, many cultures, many books.”

Performers at this year’s Yolo County Library celebrations include Kalpulli Tlayolo Aztec Dancers, Taiko Drummers, Winters and Woodland Ballet Folkloricos and Mariachi Puente.
