Woodland, CA--The Yolo County Health Department's Child Passenger Safety Seat program was awarded a California Kids Plate Grant to provide car seats to teen moms who are expecting their first child. Learning how to transport a child safely helps give children a healthy start.

To receive a seat, expectant teen moms must participate in car seat classes offered by the Health Department. The Department offers a ½ hour or 2-hour education class and fitting station in English and Spanish which teaches the basics about car seat safety and car seat installation techniques.

By attending the class, which has a low registration fee of \$25, teen moms will be eligible to receive a brand new car seat. Call today at 530-666-8645 for dates, times, and locations.

The aim of this program is to educate a new parent on child passenger safety, seat belt laws and how to install a car seat properly, securely and safely in a vehicle. Help reduce the risk of harm or injury to your child.
