(Woodland, CA) – In celebration of National Public Health Week, April 6-12, the Yolo County Health Services Department invites the community to attend this year's annual Public Health & Wellness Fair on Wednesday, April 8, from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The fair will be held in the parking lot on the southeast corner of Beamer and Cottonwood Streets in Woodland.
