ORDINANCE NO. 987

(An Ordinance Adding Article 30 to Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code, Establishing the Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is hereby amended by the addition thereto of Article 30 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 30. YOLO COUNTY ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD.

§2-2.3001. Created.

Pursuant to Section 13 of Article 13 of the California Constitution and Article 1.5 (commencing with Section 1620) of Chapter 1 of Division 1 of Part 3 of the Revenue & Taxation Code, there is hereby created in the County a Board known as the Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board.

§2-2.3002. Membership.

The Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board shall consist of three (3) members appointed directly by the Board of Supervisors. Approval of each member shall be by majority vote of the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors may appoint not to exceed six (6) alternate members.

1 §2-2.3003. Compensation.

2 Members and alternates of the Yolo
3 County Assessment Appeals Board shall be
4 compensated for attendance at regular and
5 special meetings at the rate of \$70.00 for
6 meetings of four (4) hours or less a day and
7 \$100.00 for meetings over four (4) hours per
8 day.

9 SECTION 2. Article 5 of Chapter 1 of Title 2 of the Yolo
10 County Code is hereby repealed.

11 SECTION 3. The Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board shall
12 hear all matters pending before the Yolo County Board of
13 Equalization upon appointment and qualification of the third
14 member of the Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board; provided,
15 however, the Yolo County Board of Equalization shall complete and
16 rule upon any evidentiary hearing commenced but not completed
17 before such appointment and qualification. This exception as to
18 incomplete evidentiary hearings and related rulings does not
19 extend to any matter remanded to the Yolo County Board of
20 Equalization for a new or further hearing. Such remands and all
21 matters filed before the Yolo County Assessment Appeals Board
22 shall be heard by that Board.

23 SECTION 4. Effective Date/Publication. This ordinance shall
24 take effect and be in force thirty (30) days following its
25 passage, and prior to the expiration of fifteen days after
26 adoption, this ordinance shall be published once in


1 Daily Democrat, a newspaper of general
2 circulation, printed and published in the County of Yolo.


