**(Woodland, CA)** – The community is invited to join the Yolo County Library and the Yolo County Department of Employment & Social Services in celebrating the opening of the Davis Employment & Eligibility Services One-Stop Center at the Mary L. Stephens Davis Branch Library on Wednesday, May 6, 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Employment specialists are now available to assist residents at the Davis Branch Library on Tuesdays, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Wednesdays, 2:00 to 6:00 p.m. and Thursdays, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., by providing job search and resume assistance, subsidized job assessment and placement, related workshops and other resources that assist job seekers and employers. Eligibility services for assistance such as CalFresh, CalWORKs and Medi-Cal will be provided on Tuesdays, 2:00 to 6:00 p.m.

On May 6, 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., in celebration of the opening of this new one-stop center in Davis, a reception will be held at the Mary L. Stephens Davis Branch Library, located at 315 E. 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Davis, which will include formal remarks from local leaders and clients. Refreshments will be provided.

“We are pleased to be collaborating with our library partners to bring employment and eligibility services to Davis,” said Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency Director Joan Planell. “Please join us in celebrating this new one-stop center on May 6.”
