I-5 NORTHBOUND RAMP CLOSED JUNE 24-JULY 7 FOR PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION

WOODLAND, CA – WDCWA’s transmission pipeline construction is moving ahead of schedule, bumping up a planned two-week closure for the northbound I-5 on/off ramp and County Road 22 between the East levee and County Road 117/ River Road. The I-5 ramp is expected to be closed from June 24-July 7 (originally scheduled to begin July 16). River Road will remain open. Traffic detours will be in place.

The closure will accommodate pipeline construction for WDCWA’s Regional Water Treatment Facility (RWTF). Water pipelines will connect the Joint Water Intake on the Sacramento River to the RWTF, and from the RWTF to water transmission pipelines in Woodland and Davis.
