## **Additional Hours and Support at Winters Community Library this Summer**

(Woodland, CA) – Yolo County’s Winters Community Library, located at 708 Railroad Avenue in Winters, will benefit from five additional hours of staffing this summer with the welcome return of Library Branch Supervisor Toni Mendieta.

The five extra hours of staffing run through August 8, allowing the library to be open earlier on Tuesdays and Thursdays, as well as additional hours on Saturday. The revised summer schedule is as follows:

Wednesdays 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.  
Thursdays 12:00 to 8:00 p.m.  
Saturdays 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

“The Winters Community Library will continue to review staffing and library needs as the year progresses,” said Yolo County Librarian, Patty Wong. “Meanwhile, we hope the additional hours will bring in a greater cross section of our community.”

Toni Mendieta is returning to the Winters Community Library as library branch supervisor. She brings excellent library experience along with familiarity and appreciation of the Winters community. Her duties will include overseeing the day-to-day operation of the library, providing customer service and assistance to patrons, overseeing building maintenance, supervising staff and volunteers, coordinating programs, developing the library branch collection, and other related duties. Toni is bilingual in Spanish and English and has a background in outreach and youth development.
