## **Programs at West Sacramento Library in September**

(Woodland, CA) – The following special programs will be held during the month of September at Yolo County's Arthur F. Turner Community Library, located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento:

- September 8: Get Your News Online, 9:00 a.m. Review different news websites from around the world and what they offer. Experience using a computer is recommended but not necessary. This event requires a library card, PIN and registering in person at the information desk or by phone at (916) 375-6465.
- September 10 and 22: All Things String, 6:00 p.m. For those who enjoy knitting, crocheting or embroidering. Participants are welcome to bring their current project or start something new.
- **September 16**: What's Happening Seniors, 11:15 a.m. A social group for older adults to discuss current events and issues.
- **September 16**: Evening Book Club, 6:00 p.m. Join this monthly book club and explore new worlds through reading. For more information call Cindy at (916) 731-5504.
- **September 18**: Clases Básicas de Computación, 6:00 p.m. Aprende a usar una computadora, ratón y teclado. No necesita tener experiencia, solo una tarjeta de la biblioteca y un PIN son necesarios.
- September 21: Introduction to the Computer, 10:00 a.m. This is the first session of the Cyber Senior Computer Classes and will teach participants how to turn a computer on, what the mouse and keyboard, do and other beginning functions. No experience is necessary.
- **September 24**: Tails for Tales, 4:00 p.m. School-aged children are invited to come to the library and practice reading with a therapy dog.

The following regular weekly programs for children will begin the week of September 13:

• September 15: Mother Goose on the Loose, 11:00 a.m. This award-winning program for children ages 1 to 3, parents and caregivers combines music, movement, visual literacy and language development to help children get ready to read, develop physically, emotionally and socially and encourage a positive attitude toward learning.

- **September 15**: Homework Center, 3:00 p.m. Pre-registration for this program is required. Please visit the library to complete a registration form and attend a mandatory orientation.
- **September 16**: Pre-School Story Time, 11:00 a.m. Children, ages 1 to 5, will participate in stories, songs, rhymes and finger-plays to foster reading and engage in group activities.
- September 17: Hug A Bye Baby, 11:00 a.m. This lap-sit program for children ages 0 to 12 months allows parents to share ways to stimulate language development including songs, lullabies, fingerplays and picture books. The program includes a short 'stay-and-play' session afterwards for children under 18 months.
- September 21: Buddy Reading, 4:30 p.m. This program is for children in grades K-3rd who want practice with reading. Children will be paired with a high school student from the Interact Club at River City High School for a one-on-one reading session.

The following on-going programs for adults continue in September:

- English Conversation Group, Thursdays and Fridays, 10:00 a.m.
- Russian Story Time, Tuesdays, 6:30 p.m.
- Spanish/English Bilingual Story Time, Saturdays, 11:00 a.m.
