AGENCY/BRANCH

- HHSA Managers and Supervisors attended half day training in Performance Measurement. HHSA will be rolling out performance measurement across all branches of the Agency.

- HHSA worked with school districts to develop MOUs for data sharing to identify and enroll families eligible for Free & Reduced Lunch, Medi-Cal, and CalFresh.

AFLP (ADOLESCENT FAMILY LIFE PROGRAM)

- State has given initial approval to the submitted budget and SOW. Caseload for FY 15-16 is set at 24-30

MCAH LOCAL PROGRAM

ADOLESCENT SEXUAL HEALTH

The Sexual Health Advisory Group (SHAG) held its first meeting on August 13th, 2015. Stakeholders received a brief overview of trends in sexually transmitted diseases among youth and conducted a third party comprehensive needs assessment to identify program strengths, areas for improvement, challenges, and successes. The next SHAG meeting will be held on September 10th, 2015 where we will be discussing developing a referral system for sexual health services based on the Office of Adolescent Health implementation guidelines. The CDPH Congenital Syphilis Prevention Meeting was held on September 2nd, 2015. The meeting focused on methods of disease surveillance as well as successes, challenges, and best practices in the detection and identification of congenital syphilis and female syphilis prevention. The CDPH is in the process of further developing opportunities and partnerships to assist in congenital syphilis prevention. The California Department of Education (CDE) has officially submitted just over 6,000 Youth Risk Behavior Surveys to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). The CDC expects to deliver survey results on September 25th, 2015.

CPSP ROUNDTABLE FALL 2015 - October 22, 2015, 1230pm – 2pm featuring Dr. Robert Felix, Executive Director of “**Mother to Baby California**”. **Mother to Baby** is an untapped, but well established resource for providers and agencies when issues such as medications and breastfeeding, exposure to environmental toxins and **perinatal substance use** come up. Features such as the 24/7 chat with an expert and e-referral may be key to linking mothers to information they are afraid to ask about or establishing another line of support. Mother to Baby is formerly the “California Teratogen Information Service Pregnancy Health Information Line and Clinical Research Program” based on out of UC San Diego.
