The **9th Annual Empty Bowls event on October 15, 2015** will be held at St. Luke's Church, 512 Second Street in Woodland. There will be a soup lunch at noon and dinner event at 5:30 p.m., with silent auction.

At Empty Bowls guests select one handmade bowl (donated by local artists and students) as a reminder of hunger in the world and are served a simple soup meal in exchange for a cash donation. You are asked to keep their bowl as a reminder of the meal's purpose. Each time you take your bowl from the cupboard you will be reminded that someone's bowl is always empty and that on this one occasion you helped alleviate hunger and could choose to do so again at any time.

Empty Bowls is Fourth & Hope's largest fundraiser and provides for the safety net of services breaking the cycle of homelessness, stopping substance abuse, and reuniting families.

We invite you to attend Empty Bowls and help us to provide safe shelter, food, support services, and an avenue to self-sufficiency for adults, children and families who are homeless in Woodland and Yolo County.
