MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT (MHSA): NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

MHSA Housing Program: Supportive Housing and Services Information Supportive Services Plan—Sections D.1 through D.9 180 W. Beamer Street Apartments in Woodland, CA

To all interested stakeholders, Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), in accordance with the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), is publishing this **Notice of 30-Day Public Comment Period** regarding posting of the MHSA Housing Program Supportive Service Plan, Sections D.1 through D.9, pertaining to the development of the 180 W. Beamer Street Apartments in Woodland, CA.

Through the MHSA Housing Program, Yolo County was allocated \$3.1 Million for capital development and operating subsidies for permanent supportive housing for individuals with serious mental illness who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. As required by the program, the funds were transferred to the California Housing Finance Agency (CalHFA), who will administer the funds and underwrite the loans.

The documents outline the proposed MHSA Housing Program, which will use the \$3.1 Million for capital development, specifically, the construction of twenty (20) one-bedroom units in a new 80-unit development. The 20 units will be designated as permanent supportive housing dedicated to individuals with Serious Mental Illness (SMI) who meet MHSA Full Service Partnership criteria and who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness.

The project is located in northwest Woodland (at the northeast corner of N. Cottonwood and W. Beamer Streets) and will target SMI adults age 18 and over.

- I. **The public review and comment period begins Wednesday, October 7, 2015 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 6, 2015.** Interested persons may provide written comments during the public comment period.
