## Special Screening of "Inventing America: Conversations with the Founders"

(Woodland, CA) – Come join Yolo County's Arthur F. Turner Community Library for a special screening of "Making a Nation: The Untold Story of the Declaration of Independence (1776)" on October 29 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the library, located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento.

This 70 minute episode, based on factual information, is the first in the series, "Inventing America: Conversations with the Founders". The episode highlights the origins of the Declaration of Independence through an imagined retrospective panel interview of key players that shaped America; Thomas Jefferson, John Adams and Benjamin Franklin, as well as John Dickinson, a delegate who refused to sign revealing conflict behind the historic event. Executive Producer Darell Schregardus will also discuss the production of this and upcoming episodes.
