PROPOSAL:

Pilot a secure tablet-based treatment and educational program in Yolo County correctional facilities to improve inmate access to programs and services.




Edovo is a tablet computer that offers quality education and employment resources to the nation's incarcerated population. Their progress is rewarded with access to entertainment like music, movies, and games.

WHY:

Incarceration is a unique opportunity to address the criminiogenic needs of a segment of our community, reduce criminality, and thus, reduce victims.

Programming should be seen as a public safety initiative as research consistently shows that quality education is one of the most effective forms of crime prevention. In fact, different studies have shown that effective programs have been shown to reduce recidivism by 30-60%.

Additionally, in-custody programming has been shown to keep inmates engaged and reduce incidents of violence and force within the institution. Some institutions have shown a 9% drop in jail violence in areas that have access to extensive programming, thus making the institution safer for both inmates & staff.



OVERVIEW:

- Housing Units will be equipped with SECURE wireless hotspots. Inmates will only be able to access wireless when in the day room during their timeout.
- Throught the Edovo platform, Inmates can access hundreds of hours of programming and educational content during their timeout period.
- Staff can incentive learning & track inmate progress via the Edovo platform.

NEED:

Current in-custody programming reaches roughly 20% of inmates in Leinberger Facility and only about 10% of inmates in Monroe Facility.

Moreover, inmates housed in A1 & A2 have VERY limited access to programming due to their security classification. Typically, only 2-8 inmates in these housing units receive 1-3 hours of non-religious programming each week. Inmates in A1 & A2 have more behavioral and mental health issues than mainline inmates, so it could be argued that these housing units are where programming is needed most.

Tablets and technology based programming will NOT take the place of programs and instructors. In fact, research on treatment in general indicates that the working relationship between staff and the [inmate] accounts for almost $1/3^{rd}$ of the change that occurs.

Tablets will help supplement and support existing in-custody programs. They can be used by program providers to assign homework and allow inmates to work on skills when they are not in the classroom.

More importantly, tablets will allow inmates who WANT to program but are unable due to classification or program capacity, the opportunity to learn and utilize their incarceration time for positive growth.

Since the Edovo platform is incentive based (allows inmates to access games, music, educational film clips, etc. after completing educational programs), tablets will also likely reach inmates that otherwise would NOT participate in traditional programming.

WHY EDOVO?:

Edovo is a company whose mission is to bring education rich content into the correctional setting with **no cost** to the inmate.

Our platform, Edovo, provides intuitive educational courses where inmates are rewarded for learning.

CONTENT (there's more!!):

- Tablets can integrate with and incorporate existing programming currently used in the facility.
 - Digital homework
 - Recording live classes & making them available to inmates in other parts of the facility
- Jail can upload ANY approved content & make it accessible to the entire jail population.
 - Yolo County Jail Inmate handbook
 - Local church services
 - Addresses / Phone numbers of local resources
 - Instructional videos on how to fill out a Medi-Cal application
 - Video introduction to Probation
 - Community service providers brochures

OTHER FEATURES:

- Telephone
 - Instead of there being 2 phones available in a housing unit at any given time, tablets will enable there to be 20 phones available. Inmates will no longer have to wait in line to call family & friends.
 - More access to family also means less social isolation & more community connectedness. This could reduce depression amongst inmates & reduce recidivism.
- Commissary
 - Kiosks will no longer be needed. Inmates can purchase necessary items off tablets.
- Digital Inmate Handbook
- Digital PREA
 - Automated PREA reporting

ADD-ON FEATURES:

The Edovo Platform is Customizable and there are many features possible with this technology, such as:

- Automated In-Custody Requests
 - Blue Cards
- Pink Slips
- Grievances
- PREA Reporting

- Tele-Psych
- Professional Video Visits
 - Less trips to the jail means less time and wasted gas
 - Less impact on limited programming space, potentially allowing the in-person program schedule to increase
- Legal Law Library
- Streaming to Housing Unit TVs
 - Showing education rich content rather than day-time television programs
- E-mail
- Secure e-mailing to designated accounts (Public Defender, Probation, Social Services, Child Welfare, etc.)

PROGRAM EVALUATIONS:

• Goals for the Yolo County Jail Tablet Program

- Increase the number of inmates participating in programming
- Increase the number of programming hours in the jail
- Streamline communication between inmates & attorneys, probation, service providers, etc.
- Edovo has the ability to provide detailed reports showing the following data:
 - Inmate usage (login history, number of minutes engaged, course statuses, certificates)
 - Course usage (number of inmate completions, number of inmate participants, number of hours engaged)
 - Edovo also has the capacity to create other customized reports based on Yolo County's needs
- Tablets are not yet an evidenced based practice, BUT they do utilize evidenced based curriculum and target criminogenic needs known to drive recidivism.

EXPECTED COST SAVINGS:

- Reduced Recidivism
 - Educational & Vocational education & programming have been shown to reduce recidivism by about 43%
 - For every \$1 invested in education, research estimates that incarceration costs reduce \$5 over 3 years
- Paper (no more printing inmate handbooks)

POTENTIAL COST SAVINGS:

- Time
 - Less trips to the jail for Public Defender & Probation
- Medical & Worker's Comp
 - Reduction in incidents of violence and force within the institution will mean less staff & inmate injuries

SMALL PIOLOT:

Rent With Possibility To Own

- \$25,000 for 6 month pilot program
- After 6 months, option to continue with Edovo or switch tablets provider
- 7 Wifi Hot Spots
 - 4 in A2
- 1 in B1
- 1 in A1
- 1 in B2
- 1 Charge Cart / 40 Tablets

A2 inmates – **7** hours per week (with the possibility to earn use of tablet 24 hours per day in cell)

A1 inmates – **7** hours for Ad-Seg, 5 hours for Socialization; **6-9** hours for PC; **10** hours for Gang Drop-Out per week

B1 inmates – 8-12 hours for Mainline per week

B2 – 7 hours for Ad-Seg; 8-12 hours for Mainline per week

IN CONCLUSION:

Tablets will bring easily accessible and enticing education and treatment programs to offenders who may otherwise not have access to in-custody programs or who may not seek out/participate in in-custody or out of custody programs.
