DROUGHT HOUSING RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Yolo County Office of Emergency Services (OES), is announcing the availability of temporary assistance to people who lack reasonable access to potable water resulting from the drought and who may require moving from their current residence.

The Drought Housing Relocation Assistance (DHRA) program allows eligible tenants and homeowners who meet program guideline eligibility requirements, the ability to relocate and receive a one-time moving cost allowance and rental subsidies for 12 months. Rental subsidies include assistance with security deposits; which can include the last months' rent if required by the prospective Landlord.
