Free Immunization Clinics in Winters

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency will begin holding regularly scheduled immunization clinics at the Winters Service Center, located at 111 E. Grant Avenue, on the first Monday of every other month, starting on February 1.

No appointment is needed to take advantage of this free service. All recommended vaccinations, except varicella (chicken pox), will be available for children ages 0-18 years who are uninsured, Medi-cal eligible, American Indian or Alaskan Native, and those whose insurance does not cover the needed vaccinations. The clinic will also be offering hepatitis A, hepatitis B, HPV (human papillomavirus), meningococcal and MMR (measles mumps, rubella), vaccines to uninsured or underinsured adults, 19 years and older. Flu, pneumococcal and Tdap (adult tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccines are available for adults regardless of insurance status.
