Fruit Tree Care Class February 6

(Woodland, CA) – The winter months are the optimal time to care for your fruit trees and help them stay healthy throughout the year. Join the Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency at the Hanna & Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden on Saturday, February 6 from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m. for a hands-on fruit tree care class in the garden's orchard.

This class will be taught by a UC Master Gardener of Yolo County. Participants will learn proper fruit tree training and pruning techniques to optimize tree health and fruit yield, will get tips on how to select bare root fruit trees, and will learn about ideal timing for fruit tree planting and care. Gloves and shoes that can get dirty are recommended.
