The **Lincoln Powered Parachute Field** (LPPF) is provided as a safe location from which Powered Parachutes (PPC) are integrated into the diverse collection of aeronautical activities that take place at the Lincoln Regional Airport (Karl Harder Field).

LPPF Operations will be tightly controlled during the initial 90-day testing period. Following the test phase an evaluation of the LPPF's procedures will be conducted in order to assure the safest operational practices are adopted.
