“Yes, We Have! Yes, We Will!” at the Davis Branch Library

(Woodland, CA) – Storyteller and educator, Lellingby Boyce, will honor and address the International Day of Remembrance for victims of slavery from the Transatlantic Slave Trade with “Yes, We Have! Yes, We Will!” on March 13 at 2:00 p.m. in the Blanchard Room of the Mary L. Stephens - Davis Branch Library, located at 315 E. 14th Street.

“Yes, We Have! Yes, We Will!” will address U.N. resolution 62/122 that established March 25 as the official day for this unique annual international remembrance, and will share the causes, consequences and lessons learned from the Transatlantic Slave Trade and the dangers of racism and prejudice. Participants will also learn about progress made to overcome this history and its aftermath, and will listen to stories from the past and present, including those from Davis. The audience will be invited to share relevant experiences and questions and will have the opportunity to listen to Lellingby Boyce’s new sing-along, “We Have Overcome So Much”, sung joyfully to the tune of “We Shall Overcome”.
