A winner and runner-up in each category (K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade and 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) will receive a prize, and their artwork may be used in future promotional materials in Woodland and throughout Yolo County.

The poster contest is held in collaboration with the Woodland Commit2Fit May program, and the winner and runner-up in each category will be announced at the Woodland Commit2Fit raffle event on Thursday, June 2 at 6:15 p.m., at the Woodland Community & Senior Center, located at 2001 East Street in Woodland.
