(Woodland, CA) – Over 120 parents and children attended the Early Childhood Preschool Fair held on April 9 at the Mary L. Stephens Davis Branch Library.

Parents met with seven preschool providers and ten organizations while children enjoyed arts and crafts activities and tumbling provided by the City of Davis Recreation Department. Every child left with a free goody bag containing a book, puppet and information on the library program. In addition, five lucky families won gift baskets, donated by the Friends of the Davis Public Library, First 5 Yolo, Help Me Grow and the Yolo County Office of Education Head Start/Early Start program.
