SANDENO did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 1 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that ANTHONY 2 DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and 3 MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY 4 THOMAS SANDENO did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, 5 to wit, Peter Gonzales, with malice aforethought. 6

Count Enhancement 1a : It is further alleged as to Victor Manuel Vergara that the Murder alleged in Count One was committed willfully and with premeditation and deliberation 10 within the meaning of Penal Code Section 189.

Count Enhancement 1b : It is further alleged that during the commission or attempted commission of the felony charged above, VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA did willfully, unlawfully, and personally use a deadly or dangerous weapon, within the meaning of Section 12022(b)(1) of the California Penal Code, USE OF DEADLY WEAPON.

Count Enhancement 1c : It is further alleged that at the 17 time of the commission of offense charged in this count, ANTHONY 18 DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and 19 MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY 20 THOMAS SANDENO committed the above felony for the benefit of, at 21 the direction of, or in association with any criminal street 22 gang, with the specific intent to promote, further, or assist in 23 24 any criminal conduct by gang members, and is subject to the enhancement within the meaning of Section 186.22(b)(1) of the 25 California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR CRIMINAL STREET GANG 26 ACTIVITY. 27

Count Enhancement 1d : It is also alleged that VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(22) of the California Penal Code in that VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA intentionally killed the victim while VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA was an active participant in a criminal street gang, as defined in subdivision (f) of Section 186.22, and the murder was carried out to further the activities of the criminal street gang.

Count 2 : On or about September 19, 2015, CARLOS BIVIESCAS 9 10 and ANTHONY DANIEL RIVERA and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY THOMAS 11 SANDENO did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 12 245(a)(1) of the California Penal Code, ASSAULT BY MEANS OF 13 FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY, in that ANTHONY 14 DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and 15 MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY 16 THOMAS SANDENO did willfully and unlawfully commit an assault 17 upon the person of another by means of force likely to produce 18 great bodily injury. 19

Count Enhancement 2a : It is further alleged that at the 20 time of the commission of offense charged in this count, ANTHONY 21 DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and 22 MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY 23 THOMAS SANDENO committed the above felony for the benefit of, at 24 the direction of, or in association with any criminal street 25 gang, with the specific intent to promote, further, or assist in 26 any criminal conduct by gang members, and is subject to the 27 enhancement within the meaning of Section 186.22(b)(1) of the 28

California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR CRIMINAL STREET GANG ACTIVITY.

Count 3 : On or about September 19, 2015, ANTHONY DANIEL 3 RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and 4 MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY 5 THOMAS SANDENO did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of 6 Section 186.22(a) of the California Penal Code, CRIMINAL STREET 7 GANG ACTIVITY, in that ANTHONY DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS 8 BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE SANDENO and MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS 9 and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and ZACKARY THOMAS SANDENO did 10 willfully and unlawfully actively participate in any criminal 11 street gang with knowledge that the members of that street gang 12 engage in and have engaged in a pattern of street gang activity, 13 and ANTHONY DANIEL RIVERA and CARLOS BIVIESCAS and JOSEPH GEORGE 14 SANDENO and MARTYN ALEX CONTRERAS and VICTOR MANUEL VERGARA and 15 ZACKARY THOMAS SANDENO did willfully and unlawfully promote, 16 further, and assist in any felonious criminal conduct by members 17 of that gang. 18

Case Enhancement A: It is further alleged as to ANTHONY 19 DANIEL RIVERA that he was previously convicted of a serious 20 felony within the meaning of Section 667[®] and 667(e)(1) of the 21 California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR ONE PRIOR FELONY 22 CONVICTION THAT PROHIBITS PROBATION, LIMITS CREDITS, REQUIRES 23 CONSECUTIVE SENTENCING, AND MANDATES PRISON COMMITMENT, in that 24 ANTHONY DANIEL RIVERA was convicted of a prior felony as 25 defined in Section 667(d) of the California Penal Code, and 26 listed in Sections 667.5© and 1192.7(a) of the Penal Code, and 27 Section 707(b) of the Welfare and Institutions Code, to wit: a 28

conviction for PC 245(a)(1) & 186.22(b)(1)[Occurred on October 1 9th, 2008; Conviction on January 6th, 2009], in Solano County Superior Court.

Case Enhancement B: It is further alleged as to ANTHONY 4 DANIEL RIVERA that he was previously convicted of a serious 5 felony within the meaning of Section 667(a)(1) of the California 6 Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR HABITUAL CRIMINALS, in that ANTHONY 7 DANIEL RIVERA was convicted of a serious felony listed in 8 Section 1192.7 of the Penal Code, a conviction for PC 245(a)(1) 9 & 186.22(b)(1)[Occurred on October 9th, 2008; Conviction on 10 January 6th, 2009], in Solano County Superior Court. 11

Case Enhancement C: It is further alleged as to CARLOS 12 BIVIESCAS that he was previously convicted of a prior felony and 13 sentenced to state prison within the meaning of Penal Code 14 Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR 15 PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that CARLOS BIVIESCAS was convicted of a 16 felony violation of Health and Safety Code 11378 in Solano 17 Superior Court, and sentenced to state prison on or about May 18 9th, 2014, and has not remained free of prison custody or free of 19 a felony conviction for five years, within the meaning of Penal 20 Code Section 667.5(b) 21

Case Enhancement D: It is further alleged as to CARLOS 22 BIVIESCAS that he was previously convicted of a prior felony and 23 sentenced to state prison within the meaning of Penal Code 24 Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR 25 PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that CARLOS BIVIESCAS was convicted of a 26 felony violation of Penal Code Section 245(a)(1) in Solano 27 Superior Court, and sentenced to state prison on or about April 28
