 - Patrick Blacklock shared that the Board of Supervisors are in the process of conducting a review of Child Welfare Services practices in Yolo County to get a sense of how and where they are, how they compare to national practices, and that the practices are aligned with values and policies that the Board of Supervisors wants to promote. May want the Health Council to be more involved and seek the Council’s input.

 - In regards to the recent overdose, the State has asked hospitals to voluntarily report overdoses. In addition, notifications have gone out to first responders on handling potential overdose calls.

- Roger Clarkson and Dawn Myers Purkey shared some historical and background information on Yolo Adult Day Health Center. In the early 2000s, the Board of Supervisors, as the Board of Directors for Yolo Adult Day Health Center, appointed the Health Council as a special advisory board.
- In the fall, the Board of Supervisors established a committee to address the long-term sustainability for the Adult Day Health Center. At this time, the committee is coming up to speed on the history of the center, as well as researching different models and visiting other sites across the state to determine best practices. In addition, the committee is looking at potential partners for the future. The current contract ends in June; however an interim contract with Dignity is in the process of being established until a long term plan is determined.
