Disposal Restrictions



In addition to landfilling municipal solid waste, the Yolo County Central Landfill provides programs for the safe recycling and disposal of certain regulated materials. In order for these programs to be successful and to maintain compliance with local, state and federal requirements, these materials must arrive at the facility in such a manner that the driver can easily unload these materials at the proper program areas onsite.



The following items CANNOT be mixed with municipal solid waste and include but are not limited to:

- Appliances
- Asbestos*
- Batteries (auto, alkaline, rechargeable, lithium, etc.)
- Cleaning products*
- Computer Monitors
- Cylinders (propane, fire extinguishers, helium, etc.)*
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes (incl. PCB Containing Light Ballasts)*
- Gasoline or flammables*
- Medical or Infectious Waste (pharmaceuticals, syringes, etc.)*
- Mercury Containing Devices (thermostats, thermometers, etc.)*
- Motor oil or filters
- Paint (latex and oil based)
- Pesticides and Herbicides*
- Televisions
- Tires
