- Vicinity map and directions to the site Well completion report
- Detailed description of the proposed method of well destruction (see example below):

***Preliminary well assessment** -- Provide the condition and details of the well construction, and whether there are obstructions interfering with the process of filling and sealing. The down hole camera may be used for such investigation
 ***Preparation of the hole** -- The well shall be cleaned as needed so that all undesirable materials, including obstruction objects, debris, oil from oil-lubricated pumps, or pollutants and contaminants that could interfere with the well destruction are removed for disposal.
 ***Perforation** -- Where necessary, to ensure that sealing material fills not only the well casing but also annular space or nearby voids within the zone(s) to be sealed, the casing should be perforated or otherwise punctured.
 ***Gravel-packed wells** -- The casing shall be perforated or otherwise punctured opposite the area to be sealed. The sealing material shall then be placed within the casing completely filling the portion adjacent to the area to be sealed and then forced out under pressure into the gravel envelop.
 ***Multiple aquifer wells** -- In areas where the interchange of water between aquifers will result in a significant deterioration of the water quality in one or more aquifers, the wells shall be filled and sealed in such a way that the commingling of water from one aquifer to another is prevented.

*****A minimum of 48-hour notice to a live person is required for inspection requests*****
