Subject: 2016 Pavement Rehabilitation Project in Clarksburg

Dear Resident/Business Owner:

This correspondence is provided to give you a brief overview concerning the 2016 Pavement Rehabilitation Project in Clarksburg. Construction activities are preliminarily scheduled to commence on last week of August, 2016.

The County will allow 35 working days for the road reconstruction. The Contractor will temporarily close Clarksburg Road from S.R.84 to Willow Ave to through traffic as shown on the attached project plans. Road closure will not exceed 20 working days. South River Rd from Pump house Rd to Rose Rd will be rehabilitated with a lane closure.

The contractor will be responsible to provide for local traffic access at all times to the local residents, businesses, farming operations, and property owners on Clarksburg Rd and South River Rd.

The attached plan, Sheet 6, is a construction detour plan for Clarksburg Rd, showing extent of the road closure and all the construction notification signage, which will be placed in the vicinity of the project to encourage motorists to use alternate routes during the road closure period.

During the road closure when accessing your residence or property, please be aware of uneven pavement, construction crews, and moving equipment. Please reduce your vehicle speed to travel safely during the closure period.

Right now the project is awarded to Construction Co, Inc. The Contractor will notify you soon in writing about the proposed start and completion dates, and the name and phone number of a contact person for all questions and concerns during the course of the project.

I want to assure you that every effort will be made to complete this project in a timely manner, with the least amount of inconvenience to you.
