Visit the Yolo County Library for Library Card Sign-Up Month

(Woodland, CA) – Come visit any of Yolo County’s eight library branches during the month of September for national Library Card Sign-Up Month!

Each of the Yolo County Library branches will have sign-up incentives such as stickers and bookmarks as well as information on the many free and fun programs available. For babies and toddlers there are programs such as story time and Mother Goose on the Loose. For children and teens there is Tales for Tails, Homework Help, The Spot, and even programs involving science, technology, and art. For adults and seniors, programs can vary from book clubs to tai chi, and from wisdom circles to poetry readings. All branches have computers for public use and free Wi-Fi connection.

If you are interested in services, the One Stop Career Center provides free job assistance while LINK+ allows cardholders to browse and borrow more than 11 million items from over 50 participating public and academic libraries in California and Nevada. Discover and Go provides cardholders with access to free and low-cost passes to over 40 museums, science centers, zoos, theatres and other cultural venues throughout Northern California and the San Francisco Bay Area. If you need technological support, the IT Consultant assists card holders who have questions about their mobile device or laptop.
