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## **Board of Supervisors Seeking Applications for Community Services Action Board**

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is seeking applications for several openings on its Community Services Action Board (CSAB).

### **CSAB Mission**

CSAB's mission is to combat poverty by promoting the health, safety, stability, and self-sufficiency of low-income persons residing in Yolo County.

### **Primary Functions**

CSAB serves as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors, and its primary functions include:

- Convening bi-monthly meetings to evaluate local progress towards combating poverty in Yolo County
- Conducting a biannual community needs assessment to identify critical gaps in Yolo County's social service system
- Overseeing the provision of services using Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds by reviewing project proposals and making recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on how to expend the money
- Monitoring the performance of CSBG funded programs by examining outcome reports and conducting annual site visits
- Serving as advocates for Yolo County residents living in poverty

### **Board Openings**

CSAB currently has seven vacancies to be filled, including:

- 3 representatives of the low-income population (may be low-income persons, or persons working for an organization serving the low-income population)
- 1 representative of a local civic organization
- 1 representative of District 1 (to be appointed by Supervisor Oscar Villegas)
- 1 representative of District 2 (to be appointed by Supervisor Don Saylor)
- 1 representative of District 5 (to be appointed by Supervisor Duane Chamberlain)

Yolo County will reimburse members who qualify as low-income for travel and/or childcare expenses incurred when attending the meeting.

### **Meeting Schedule**

CSAB meets on the second Tuesday of every other month from 4:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. in rotating locations among Davis, West Sacramento, and Woodland. The current members are willing to change the meeting time to accommodate schedules of new members if necessary.
