Overview:

July 2016 revenues exceeded budget forecasts by \$10,000 and were \$10,500 ahead of prior year. Rounds for the month were 20 rounds under projections for July, but matched the prior year. Green fee/cart revenue made up most of the revenue surplus, coming in \$9,500 better than projections. Pro Shop generated \$2,743 better than projections however F&B was short of budget by \$1,029. The weather during July was very warm and there were 10 days with temperatures over 100°F, and 13 additional days above 90°F. NOI gained \$10,985 to budget projections, and was \$4,384 better than the prior year. Payroll came in \$2,931 over budget, while Operating Expenses came in \$2,526 better than projections.

• Converted Rounds: 904 of the 2,044 rounds recorded for July were 18 hole rounds. Converting those rounds to 9 hole rounds resulted in a total of 2,948 rounds for July. Total converted rounds for the fiscal year are 2,948.



Key Operational Highlights:

Course & Grounds:

The following tasks were completed during the month of July

- Reseeded and sanded divots on tees.
- Sprayed greens and collars for fairy ring disease.
- Sprayed for caterpillars (cutworms) in putting green.
- Sprayed herbicide for weeds in landscaped areas and fence lines.
- Sprayed herbicides around bunker edges.
- Repaired broken pipes on holes #4 and #8.
- Repaired leaking sprinklers on holes #1, #4, #6, #8 and #9.
- Replaced blades on rough mower.
- Replaced bushings on lift arms of fairway mower.
- Changed oil in rough mower and replaced oil and hydraulic filters.
- Continued with installing landscape fabric.

Personnel

• There were no personnel changes in July.

General

- Payroll was \$2,931 over budget projections.
- Operating Expenses were \$2,526 under budget.
- Food & Beverage revenue was short of budget projections by \$1,029. We continue to
 offer Food & Beverage service from the Golf Shop serving hot dogs, snacks and drinks.
 The Nest Restaurant continues to be utilized for tournament banquets and other catered
 events.
- There were five (5) outside events during the month, ranging from 24 players to 44 players. Men's Thursday Night Twilight league continued, with 4 weeks of competition.
- Continue marketing our reduced rates and expanded our database to draw new players to the course.

Key Actions to Drive Performance:

• Good weather and reduced green fees are still forces that continue to drive rounds.

Key property action steps by management to drive performance:

- Running e-mail promotions to promote weekday tee times
- Weekly Sales calls to groups for booking events
- Use of online coupons on Wild Wings website for monthly specials
- Continue to work on booking banquet events for the Nest
