RECOMMENDED ACTION



BACKGROUND

The Yolo County Local Agency Formation Commission staff received an application for the Orciuoli Reorganization to the Esparto CSD and MERCSA on October 9, 2007. The petition proposes that approximately 40 acres of land; adjacent to the northwest boundary of the town of Esparto, south of State Highway 16, West of Parker Street, and north of Duncan Drive (see Map 1); be annexed to the Esparto Community Services District (CSD) and the Madison-Esparto County Service Area to receive municipal (water, wastewater, street lighting, parks and recreation, and drainage) services. The project applicant also applied for a sphere amendment for the Esparto CSD on October 1, 2007, and MERCSA on January 28, 2008, to include this project in their respective Spheres of Influence. The Certificate of Filing was issued by the Executive Officer on April 4, 2008.
