Voter Registration Deadline

(Woodland, CA) – For those interested in casting their vote in the upcoming Presidential Election, an important deadline is rapidly approaching. Monday, October 24th is the last day Yolo County residents can register in order to participate in the November process. “Your voice matters. Make sure it can be heard on Election Day,” said Jesse Salinas, Yolo County Registrar of Voters. “This will be an important election and I encourage anyone who has not already registered to vote to do so prior to the **October 24, 2016** registration deadline.”

To qualify to register to vote, a voter must be 18 years of age on Election Day, be a resident of the County of Yolo for at least 15 days before the election and be a citizen of the United States.

Residents can register online to vote by visiting the California Secretary of State’s California Voters webpage at <http://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/cavoter> . Potential voters may also submit a completed Affidavit of Registration to the Yolo County Elections Office at 625 Court Street, Room B-05, Woodland, CA 95695. Affidavits can be obtained and submitted to the Elections Office directly or mailed, however mailed affidavits must be postmarked by the October 24, 2016 deadline and received by the Elections Office no later than three days after that date.
