

March 27: Board of Supervisors Public Hearing

The Yolo County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to adopt a Preferred Land Use Alternative for the 2030 Yolo County General Plan Update. The Preferred Alternative will be the basis for preparing the Draft General Plan and Environmental Impact Report for public review.

On February 6, 2007, the Board of Supervisors heard testimony from over 60 individuals, deliberated over eight hours, and provided its concerns and direction to staff, on a Preferred Alternative. The Board continued the item to March 27.

The public hearing will be on Tuesday, March 27, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m. (earlier than usual), in the Board of Supervisors Chambers in the Erwin Meier Administration Center at 625 Court Street, Woodland, California. Public comments will be at the discretion of the Chair of the Board. Any written materials should be submitted in advance.
