(Woodland, CA) – All are welcome to participate in the following special programs held during the month of December at Yolo County's Arthur F. Turner Community Library, located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento:

- **December 2, 9, 16, 23 & 30:** I SEE YOU, 1:00 p.m. People who are experiencing homelessness are welcome to attend free art classes through the I SEE YOU YoloArts project that is aimed to increase community engagement through the arts. Weekly art classes will be led by professionals on topics such as photography, drawing, painting, printmaking, collage and creative writing. Project is funded by the James Irvine Foundation's Exploring Engagement Fund grant.
- **December 5: FREE Hearing Screening and Phone, 1:00 p.m.** Come for a hearing screening and get your free phone the same day! Hearing screenings performed by Deborah R.
