Wood Chips for Sale at the Landfill

(Woodland, CA) – Seven days a week, residents can now purchase landscaping wood chips at the Yolo County Central Landfill, located at 44090 County Road 28H in Woodland.

Yolo County has begun producing wood chips made entirely from wood waste brought into the landfill. This 100% recycled product comes in natural at \$25/cubic yard, as well as colored (red, black and brown) at \$45/cubic yard. A one-cubic yard minimum of wood chips can be picked up during regular open hours (Monday through Saturday 6:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sunday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and landfill staff will be on hand to load the material at no charge.

“This is just one of our efforts to recover, recycle and repurpose materials disposed of at the landfill, and turn it around to provide the public a product for sale,” said Yolo County Integrated Waste Management Division Director Linda Sinderson. “Stay tuned for more information in the months to come on additional products for sale at landfill.”

With the exception of a few holidays, including the upcoming Christmas and New Year’s holidays, the Yolo County Central Landfill is open seven days a week, providing a host of services ranging from household hazardous waste collection to holiday tree recycling.
