Fruit Tree Care Class January 25

(Woodland, CA) – The winter months are the optimal time to care for your fruit trees and help them stay healthy throughout the year. Join the Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency at the Hanna & Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden on Wednesday, January 25 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. for a hands-on fruit tree care class in the garden's orchard.

Two UC Master Gardeners of Yolo County are teaming up to teach this class. Both have a wealth of knowledge to share about how to select and plant bare root fruit trees, as well as how to take care of your fruit trees to improve yield.

This class is free to all, and is part of the Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency's commitment to providing education that can help residents eat fresh fruits and vegetables and live healthier lives.
