Meeting Minutes

August 28, 2013

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm by Chair Bonnie Wolstoncroft.
2. Minutes from previous meeting was approved (Kathy/Antoinette)
3. Regular Agenda- Status of Water Project- Supervisor Saylor began with the discussion of an alternative water mitigation alternative of consolidation with the City of Davis water system. It was discussed that the City of Davis could potentially receive significant cost savings by connecting the NDM water system and utilizing the State Revolving Funds.
4. Herb Neiderberger and Diana Jensen presented the pros for the City of Davis in the consolidation alternative. Correspondence between the NDM CSA and the City of Davis from May 22, 2013 and July 15, 2013 was shared (uploaded on CSA website link). There was discussion of the City of Davis terms for the agreement. The direction that was given was for the continuation of discussions with the City of Davis.
5. There was a discussion about Chrome 6 and the limited data that is available at this time. It was noted that Chrome 6 public health goal is currently being set, but the MCL will not be disclosed until a future to be determined date. The City of Davis staff mentioned that the City will be reviewing its current Chrome 6 levels in their wells very soon. It was also mentioned that there could be a potential problem with Chrome 6 in any wells drilled in North Davis Meadows and it would make sense to review data prior to drilling.
6. The Comparison cost sheet was provided showing the consolidation cost alternative compared to the well drilling scenario. The worksheet was also included on the website.
7. There was a statement made by City of Davis staff that the City would be talking to CDPH regarding the State revolving fund loans and would be talking to the Regional Water Quality Control Board regarding the same. These discussions would also include CSA/County Staff and the consideration of NDM.
8. There was a question and answer sheet dispersed and discussed. This handout was also included on the website. Some of the questions were regarding the individual cost for piping from each home to the meter should the consolidation option be actualized. The answers are still not available other than the cost could be estimated and would be known prior to the project moving forward and any bonding or financing happening. The cost would need to be included in any Prop.
