

Emergency Management Mutual Aid (EMMA) Plan



EMMA Plan - Overview

- Establishes statewide system for ordering emergency management personnel and technical specialists
- Follow SEMS levels
- · CalEOC is the ordering system
- EMMA Coordinators at local, OA, Region, and State levels



EMMA Plan - Responders

EMMA Responders MUST:

- Be qualified for that position/task
 - EOC Credentialing will be a source of establishing qualifications
- · Have appropriate training
- Be public employees
- Be able to deploy for at least 7 days



EMMA Plan - Request Process

- Requesting OA inputs request in CalEOC
- CalOES Region notifies other OAs of request
- Responding OAs submit candidates in CalEOC
- Requesting OA selects candidate(s) and coordinates deployment directly



EMMA Plan - Update

- 2012 EMMA Plan is currently being updated
 - -EMMA SEMS Specialist Committee
- Focus is more local ownership for use of Plan
