	Services of California. The current monthly premium is \$9.28 with

Life Insurance	The County provides a \$25,000 life insurance policy.
Deferred Compensation	Employees receive a limited annual match based on years of
	service: 5 years = $$150$; 10 years = $$200$
Sick Leave	Employees earn 8 hours of sick leave per month.
Vacation	New employees earn the equivalent of 80 hours of vacation time
	off per year and are eligible to use vacation after 13 pay periods of
	employment. The accrual rate increases to 104 hours after 5 years
	of employment.
Floating Holidays	Employees earn 32 hours each fiscal year.
Holidays	Yolo County has 10 paid holidays each year.
Disability (State	Employees participate in the State of California disability program.
Disability Insurance)	SDI benefits may be supplemented with accrued leave balances.
