Vision Insurance	All employees are required to enroll in our plan with Medical
	Eye Services of California. The current monthly premium is
	\$9.28 and is deducted from the benefit package. Family
	members may be added at no additional cost. A Buy Up plan
	with enhanced coverage is also available.
Life Insurance	The County provides a \$50,000 life and AD&D policy.
Auto Allowance	Members of the Board of Supervisors receive \$570 monthly.
