



## Yolo County Benefits Management Unit Employees January 2017

<b>CalPERS Retirement</b> <i>Classic Members</i> <b>2.5% @ 55 (Misc.)</b> <b>3% @ 55 (Safety)</b>	Employees in the miscellaneous category pay approximately 8% of salary toward retirement. Employees in the safety category pay approximately 9% of salary toward retirement.
<b>CalPERS Retirement</b> <i>New Members</i> <b>2% @ 62 (Misc.)</b> <b>2.7% @ 57 (Safety)</b>	Employees in the miscellaneous category pay 6.25% of CalPERS reportable earnings toward retirement. Employees in the safety category pay 11.25% of CalPERS reportable earnings toward retirement.
<b>Social Security &amp; Medicare</b>	All Yolo County employees participate in Social Security and Medicare.
<b>Health Insurance</b>	Yolo County offers 9 health plans (6 HMO's and 3 PPO's). Each employee receives a benefit package of \$20,454 annually to purchase health, dental and vision insurance. Any remaining balance of the benefit package will be paid to the employee as taxable earnings. This amount is pro-rated for part-time employees.
<b>Dental Insurance</b>	All employees are required to enroll in our Delta Dental Plan. The current monthly premium is \$88.00 and is deducted from the benefit package. Family members may be added at no additional cost. A Buy Up plan with enhanced coverage is also available.
<b>Vision Insurance</b>	All employees are required to enroll in our plan with Medical Eye Services of California. The current monthly premium is \$9.28 and is deducted from the benefit package. Family members may be added at no additional cost. A Buy Up plan with enhanced coverage is also available.
<b>Deferred Compensation</b>	Employees receive a limited annual match based on years of service: 1 year = \$400; 10 years = \$500
<b>Life Insurance</b>	The County provides a \$50,000 life insurance policy.
<b>Sick Leave</b>	Employees earn 8 hours of sick leave per month.
<b>Vacation</b>	New employees earn the equivalent of 80 hours of vacation time off per year and are eligible to use vacation after 13 pay periods of employment. The accrual rate increases to 104 hours after 5 years of employment.
<b>Administrative Leave</b>	Employees receive 48 hours of administrative leave each fiscal year.
<b>Floating Holidays</b>	Employees earn 32 hours each fiscal year.
<b>Holidays</b>	Yolo County has 10.5 paid holidays each year.
<b>Disability (County Disability Insurance)</b>	Employees are eligible for a short-term disability benefit of 75% of salary.
<b>Employee Assistance Program</b>	Employees have a confidential counseling program available for up to 6 visits per incident each fiscal year.
