CalPERS Retirement	Employees pay approximately 9% of salary toward retirement.
Classic Members	Employees pay approximately 5% of safary toward remement.

Social Security &	All Yolo County employees participate in Social Security and Medicare.

Health Insurance	Yolo County offers 10 health plans (6 HMO's and 4 PPO's). Yolo
	County pays the following monthly portion of the premium:

	The County contribution is equal to 90% of the premium of the lowest
	cost health plan.
In-Lieu of Health	Employees who do not enroll in health insurance are eligible to receive
Insurance Program	\$300 monthly (less applicable payroll taxes) upon proof of adequate
	health insurance coverage.
Dental Insurance	All employees are required to enroll in our Delta Dental Plan. The
	current monthly premium is \$88.00 with the County paying 90%. Family
	members may be added at no additional cost. A Buy Up plan with
	enhanced coverage is also available.
Vision Insurance	All employees are required to enroll in our plan with Medical Eye
	Services of California. The current monthly premium is \$9.28 with the
	County paying 90%. Family members may be added at no additional
	cost. A Buy Up plan with enhanced coverage is also available.
Life Insurance	The County provides a \$25,000 life insurance policy.
Deferred	Employees receive a limited annual match based on years of service:
Compensation	5 years = \$100; 10 years = \$150
Sick Leave	Employees earn 8 hours of sick leave per month.
Vacation	New employees earn the equivalent of 80 hours of vacation time off per
	year and are eligible to use vacation after 13 pay periods of employment.
	The accrual rate increases to 104 hours after 5 years of employment.
Vacation Buyback	Employees with a balance over 240 hours may request to purchase up to
	40 hours each fiscal year.
Floating Holidays	Employees earn 40 hours each fiscal year.
Holidays	Yolo County has 9 paid holidays each year.
Employee Assistance	Employees have a confidential counseling program available for up to 6
Program	visits per incident each fiscal year.
