June Programs at the West Sacramento Branch Library

(Woodland, CA) – All are welcome to participate in the following special programs held during the month of June at Yolo County's Arthur F. Turner Community Library, located at 1212 Merkley Avenue in West Sacramento:

- **Read off Your Fines!: May 26 August 19.** This year the Read Off Your Fines campaign will be held in conjunction with the Summer Reading Program. Participants will be able to deduct \$1.00 from their fines for every 15 minutes spent reading a book of their choice in the library and also use those minutes toward earning incentives in the Summer Reading Program.
- Lunch at the Library: Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday, 12:00 p.m. Children (ages 6-12) are invited to come out and enjoy a FREE lunch at the library. After lunch fun, educational activities will be provided. Pre-registration is required.

This program is suitable for children 6 to 12 years old. Families with younger children are welcome to attend this event.

In this hands-on environment, babies will explore their creative side and foster their learning of colors, shapes, and more!
