1. Introductions and Program Updates

Ian Evans will be the new Alcohol and Drug Administrator for Yolo County. Additionally, the Drug Medical implementation plan has been approved.

Karen Larsen announced that Yolo County received the Prop 37 Grant which awards \$6 Million over the span of three years to serve those that have criminal offences and substance use disorders.

Project staffing and sub-contracting regarding CBO contracts are driven by the current model of homeless neighborhood court. This is a restorative justice model with intense wrap around support. This program will start in Fall of 2017.

FINI Grant was awarded to Yolo County for \$500,000 over the next three years, allowing for recipients of CalFRESH to receive an extra \$30 each month to purchase fruits and vegetables.
