COMBINED MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW (MSR) AND SPHERE OF INFLUENCE STUDY (SOI) OF THE SIX PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICTS IN YOLO COUNTY

The Draft Combined Municipal Service Review (MSR) for the Yolo County Public Cemetery Districts will be available for public review beginning July 1, 2017, at the office of the Yolo LAFCo and online at www.yololafco.org. On the basis of the Municipal Service Review and in accordance with Government Code Section 56425(g), staff has reviewed the Spheres of Influence (SOI) of each agency and recommends that a SOI Update is not necessary at this time. Therefore, no change to the agencies' SOI is recommended.

The intent of the MSR is to review the services being provided by all six Yolo County public cemetery districts; Capay, Cottonwood, Davis, Knights Landing, Mary's, and Winters. The Commission will receive an overview of the draft MSR and will consider recommendations for MSR determinations for each District. The public hearing will include an overview of comments received and responses to those comments. Public comments will also be taken at the hearing. Following public comment, the Commission will be asked to adopt the MSR determinations.
