DISCUSSION ITEMS

Rezoning: The Chairman informed the Committee that the Board of Supervisors voted to remove the Dunnigan Specific plan from the County General Plan. They indicated that they would consider development in the future for areas north of County Road 6 between 88 and I5 and West of Road 99W between Road 8 and 6.

CSA Lighting: A LAFCO report indicated that they did not feel a change in the Sphere of Influence was needed at this time for the lighting District. Due to the high cost of administering the CSA they indicated it might be best to be combined into an existing CSD.

FLASHING ROAD SIGN: The solar powered flashing speed sign has been installed North of the Post Office on 99W. It appears to be slowing down a lot of speeders even though we still have some exceeding the speed limit. It appears to be working.

MARIJUANA in Residential Areas: The Chairman informed the attendance that if they have questions on growing or to report a grow site to contact the Yolo County Agricultural Commissioner in Woodland. The Chairman also went over Medical Cultivation Ordinance as proposed by the County. There was a lengthy discussion concerning the Ordinance and how it might affect the Community. A local resident familiar with Marijuana Cultivation answered numerous questions the audience had.
